



Nordik Spa-Nature donates over \$35,000 To the Quebec Cancer Foundation

Chelsea, October 14, 2014 – Nordik Spa-Nature is proud to announce that as part of its partnership with the Quebec Cancer Foundation, the spa has donated over \$35,000 this year. The Quebec Cancer Foundation has been the major annual cause supported by Nordik Spa-Nature since 2013.
