#### A unique space

Thermëa spa village proposes a variety of wellness rituals and treatments, such as the Aufguss ceremonies in what is the largest event sauna in North America, our signature Rhassul mud treatment and our Himalayan salt inhalation sauna where visitors can fully enjoy the benefits of thermotherapy.

Those coveting the experience of weightlessness will be pleased to try the much-anticipated Källa saltwater underground floating pool, considered as the pinnacle of relaxation within the spa village.

As for the culinary experience, it will be composed of several food outlets from the casual setting of the Biërgarden, overlooking the site, to the restaurant where you can discover our farm to table offerings, to the chill lounge area overlooking the pond. Whether it be inside or outside, there truly is something for everyone to enjoy.

Its innovative and integrated technologies such as our RFID bracelets, will ensure that guests enjoy a seamless experience from the minute they reserve online and throughout their visit.

"We have gone to great lengths, taking the individual elements that make our spas unique, in order to integrate them into the natural landscape of the village. The rustic buildings at the core give the impression that they've always been there, and that the spa was built around them. It is an important part of our design philosophy to reuse materials and give them a second or third life. This is notably the case with the stones from the original Cullen Garden Park which will be used in several features at the spa," says Groupe Nordik Senior Designer, Antoine Lagarec. "This helps create an authentic atmosphere, a place where the spirit of the community comes to life and where new memories are forged."
