The spa village incorporates innovative technology created in collaboration with an international team of experts, such as Fläm, a proprietary duo-energy driven sauna, as well as Kello, a sauna with a unique auto-infusion technology. The iconic water tower brings guests an innovative cold plunge experience, merging experiential with wellness.

In addition to the selection of saunas, the village offers two steam rooms, seven baths, and multiple rest areas. One of the highlights of this state-of-the-art facility is Källa, the largest saltwater floatation pool in North America. Guests will be able to select from a large variety of body care and massage treatments, as well as the Rhassoul clay treatment, a new addition inspired by Middle Eastern traditions created specifically for the Whitby location.

With key learning from our other spas, every detail of the site has been carefully thought out and chosen to create a unique place to feel at ease.
